## NOTES

1. **BDI** -Terms of Insurance as from 2001
  - A colony is a hive regardless of size
  - If a claim is received and the beekeeper is found to be under-insured then that claim will be invalid and no payment will be made.
  - If premiums are paid after 15<sup>th</sup> March in any year the insurance will not commence until 41 days later
  - The Treasurer of the Association acts as agent of the BDI
  - A minimum of £2.00 BDI per year must be paid by all Registered and Partner members .
- Additional BDI Premiums** for the year commencing 1<sup>st</sup> April 2012 are:  
4 - 5 cols.- £2.00; 6 - 10 cols.- £5.25; 11 - 15 cols.- £7.75; 16 - 20 cols.- £9.50; 21 - 25 cols.- £ 11.10; 26-30 cols - £ 11.10; 31 – 35 - £16.10; 36 – 39 - £18.10. More than 39 colonies are insured through Scheme B.  
(1-3 - £2.00 included in Registered & Partner membership)
2. **CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP**- taken from The Rules of PDBKA
  - Registered - any person keeping bees is eligible.
  - Partner - beekeeper at same address as Registered.
  - Country - non-beekeeper wanting to keep membership of HBA and BBKA.
  - Associate - any non-beekeeper or full member of another BBKA affiliated Beekeeping Association is eligible.
  - Family - any member of the family of a Registered or Associate Member living at the same address is eligible.
  - Junior with bees - such members shall be under the age of 18 at the 30<sup>th</sup> November and keep (i.e. overwinter) not more than three colonies.
  - Junior no bees - such members shall be under the age of 18 at the 30<sup>th</sup> November and who do not have their own bees.
  - Any new member joining from 1<sup>st</sup> September shall not pay subscriptions until February.
3. **BBKA & HBA columns** These figures are the BBKA and the HBA capitation that PDBKA have to pay per member. For Junior (with bees), Capitation is paid by PDBKA. BBKA capitation funds BBKA news, public and product liability for all members up to a maximum of £5 million and is used to underwrite events such as conferences and the exhibition at the Royal Show as well as sponsoring research projects and education programmes. HBA capitation funds Bee Talk every quarter and underwrites the annual conference and education programme among other things.
4. **Data Protection Act 1998** -The PDBKA is exempt from notification under the 1998 Act but it is required to comply with the eight Data Protection Principles.  
The data, which you supply on this form, will be held electronically for internal administration by the Honorary Treasurer and the Honorary Secretary and Membership Secretary. It will be distributed as a membership list, showing name, mail and email address and telephone number. The membership list will be sent to: All current PDBKA members (if you do not want other PDBKA members to have your details make sure that you tick the box on the other side), Hampshire Beekeepers Association, The British Beekeepers Association and Regional Bee Inspector - DEFRA - (this includes the Seasonal Bee Inspector)  
*Data will not be disclosed to any other third party without your express permission.*
5. **BBKA Research Fund** - Donation  
BBKA is continuing to request donations to their Research Fund, which looks into the control of bee diseases. This valuable service merits the support of all beekeepers.  
You can make a voluntary donation using this form.  
The Honorary Treasurer will collect and forward such donations.
6. **Gift Aid.** All the money you pay the association except BDI premiums (which the association acts as agents for) are eligible for Gift Aid provided that you pay UK income or capital gains tax of at least the amount that we are claiming in the current tax year. It is important that you notify us if your circumstances change, either name, address or if you cease to pay tax.
7. **Membership Payment.** This must be received by the Honorary Treasurer by **15 March** as he will not be processing the subscriptions between 15 March and 1 April. Any received after 15 March would therefore incur the 40 day break of BDI cover.
8. **Internet Transfers.** There is now the facility for this. Account Number: 00798895. Sort Code:30-93-17. If you use this method of payment **it is essential that your name is in the transfer details..**
9. **Cheque Payment.** Cheques should be made payable to; Petersfield & District Beekeepers Association.
10. **Bee-Talk.** HBA has decided normally to distribute this by email from now on. However, for those who do not want it in this form, there is still the option to receive it by post. For those who wish to take our Newsletter by email but Bee-Talk by post, please tick the box but write “ Bee-talk by post” alongside.
